Location, dwelling type and required travel distances will be considered during the application process and any additional charges will be advised prior to installation.

Free set-up offer terms and conditions

Customers must meet the eligibility criteria set by the Australian Government's Australian Broadband Guarantee. Offer is available on a 12-month contract. If the service is moved, transferred or cancelled within this period a \$120 pro-rate fee will apply. For any service moved, additional costs will also be charged. Free set-up applies to standard installation which involves a single storey, 84cm satellite dish roof mount. Additional charges may apply for non-standard installation. Location, dwelling type, freight and required travel distances will be considered during the application process and additional charges advised prior to installation.

Download Allowance

Am I eligible for the ABG?

Finding out if you're eligible for the Australian Broadband Guarantee (ABG) is easy. Simply visit the

You may also qualify for more than one Australian Broadband Guarantee subsidy if:-

- A business is run separately from your home premises,
- If you move to a premises eligible for the subsidy.

Residential customers are eligible for more than one free connection on the same premises if you reside in a distinct house, self-contained unit or apartment. This includes:-

- Separate dwellings on a single farming property,
- Retirement villages or nursing homes,
- A caravan permanently located in a caravan park or a boat (but only in a nominated home port and only when technology makes delivery of the service possible).
